We are pleased to announce that Doshisha Women's College of Liberal Arts (DWCLA) has begun accepting applications for the Japanese Studies Program 2018.

### Japanese Studies Program (JSP)

- The JSP 2018 offers both introductory Japanese language and Japanese culture & society courses for English speaking female students whose first language is not Japanese. The culture courses are conducted in English. (\*DWCLA will give one credit for each of the four Japanese language courses and two credits for each Japanese culture & society courses. Credit transfer will depend on the decision of the home institution.)

The JSP 2018 will be held as followed schedule;

Orientation: September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018

Class: from September 25<sup>th</sup> to December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018

- Grants of **200,000 yen** are available for participants from the affiliated colleges and universities. Recipients will receive 20,000 yen cash on the first orientation day, and the remaining 180,000 yen will automatically be allocated as follows: (Homestay) 60,000 yen × 3 months, (Kyoto Ryugakusei House) 24,800 yen × 3 months & 35,200 yen × 3 months for meals.

Please note that students can only apply for this program through their home institutions. Therefore, we would like to ask for your kind cooperation in advising your students regarding the application procedures for this program.


Please find enclosed several copies of the JSP posters and brochures. It would be greatly appreciated if you could publicize the program with them.
