PRACTICAL MATTERS

Nomination (<i>New procedure</i>)	Partner Universities will have to fill out the Nomination Form and email this to their contact person at ISD (see above).
Nomination period	Winter semester: 1 February - 15 May Spring semester: 1 September - 15 October
Application period	Winter semester: 1 February - 1 June Spring semester: 1 September - 1 November
Application deadline for students from Pakistan, Bangladesh and Nepal	Winter Semester: 1 April Spring Semester: 1 November
Semester dates	Winter Semester (WS): September – February Spring Semester (SS): February – July The academic calendar can be found here .
Welcome Day	At the start of each semester we organise a Welcome Day for all new international students. On this day students get their first real taste of Dutch culture and receive information about important practical matters. Accepted students will receive an invitation by email. The Welcome day is not mandatory, but is highly recommended. For students with a non-European nationality we also organise a Pre-Welcome Day .
Language of instruction	The language of instruction for all our exchange programmes is English.
English language requirements	Exchange students are not required to submit proof of their English proficiency. Partner institutions are expected to select students who have a good standard of English. Partner institutions are advised to use the requirements for fee-paying Bachelor students as a guideline: TOEFL 550 or IELTS 6.0.
Possibility of attending courses from different departments	Students can only apply for an exchange programme of the <i>Schools</i> as stated in the institutional agreement. Most <i>Schools</i> offer fixed semester programmes (30 ECTS). Unfortunately, it is not possible to 'mix and match' courses from different <i>Schools</i> .
Learning Agreements	Learning Agreements will be forwarded by ISD to the departmental coordinator of the <i>School</i> . The <i>School</i> will return the signed document to you a.s.a.p.
Accommodation	Hanze UAS does not offer on-campus accommodation. For more information about housing please check our website . If you have any questions about housing or are experiencing problems, please contact our Housing Manager at housing@org.hanze.nl
